APA ACTIVITIES FOR THE PAST YEAR

PLACEPLANNING

Heavy involvement in the Community Reference Group Conrad Grayson represented APA, followed by Ros Marsh Trial closure of Old Barrenjoey Rd Draft plan to be available before CRG meeting on 23 January 2020 Concern that Council may not be recognising community input adequately. Report to go to February Council meeting, then to public exhibition.

TREE CANOPY

Submission made to Northern Beaches Council Draft Tree Canopy Plan APA co-operating with Council on tree planting program , species and locations Concern that preservation is not being properly enforced.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT POLICY

A new policy required by State Government---now adopted APA contributed to development of policy

CREATIVE ART SPACE

After initial \$2.2 million plans for Avalon, \$4million allocated instead to Mona Vale and only \$260k to Avalon.

APA represented by Ros Marsh and Barrenjoey Alliance for Arts and Culture led by Sue Boaden Council plans for Avalon Beach Golf Club not satisfactory and have now been revised.

PRIVATE DEVELOPMENT ON SHORE BRACE RESERVE

APA supported local residents demands for removal of extensive private intrusion into this reserve. Council agreed to require removal of most of the unauthorised work.

PARTICIPATION WITH PITTWATER COMMUNITY ALLIANCE

PCA represents 13 resident associations from Palm Beach to Warriewood and is led by Craig Boaden APA has participated in meetings with Council and with Rob Stokes on broader issues affecting our combined area.

NETBALL COURTS

Original plan for 4 hard courts for netball and a half basketball court. APA attended a public meeting and lodged submissions

After much community opposition plans were revised to 2 hard courts for netball on Barrenjoey Rd side of Careel Creek [where there are old grass courts] together with a half basketball court adjoining the skateboard ramp and 2 grass courts along the Yellow Brick Rd.

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRACKS

Unfortunately young bike riders have prepared tracks which have done considerable damage to Palmgrove Park and Stapleton Reserve.

COASTAL WALKWAY

APA has sought changes to the proposed walkway at South Avalon headland and across the grass behind the bus stop and opposed the building at Bilgola Beach which is contrary to the agreed concept plan for that area. We are now seeking detailed plans for the route from Newport to Avalon Beach

TOWARD 2040

This is the new Local Strategic Planning Statement as required by the State Government. It sets the strategic environment and direction for the new combined NBC Local Environment Plan and Development Control Plan which are to be completed by mid 2020. An important part of the LEP will be the preparation of Local Character Statements for each locality within NBC eg, Avalon Beach Area.
