APA 56th Annual General Meeting 2023

Thursday 23 November, 7 pm at the Avalon Beach Surf Life **Saving Club**

Our guest speaker was Northern Beaches Council's recently appointed CEO, Scott Phillips. Scott commenced in this role at end of July.

He commented that NBC is big: on services, complexity, community engagement as well as geographic diversity. Combining the three LGAs has added to the complexity and is delivering economies of scale.

Scott started his career as a town planner in Wyong, then MacArthur, then Hornsby where he was first appointed CEO. He spoke about the housing crisis in NSW with the state government announcing the plan to construct 380,000 new dwellings in 10 years in NSW. This will put pressure on NBC to plan for more housing. He also spoke about NBC's financial position, which while healthy, will require us have conversations about revenue and cost of services.

The second half of Scott's session was questions from the audience including discussion of the following topics:

- Capacity for certain areas with appropriate infrastructure (e.g. Frenchs Forest, Brookvale) to be allocated higher housing density
- Placemaking and acknowledging the Northern Beaches area is not homogenous
- Prioritising the natural environment and protection thereof
- Sustainability of housing design
- Amenity such as pathways for pedestrians

CURRENT ISSUES IN AVALON

NBC Council Draft Conservation Zones Review

The NSW Department of Planning has recommended that Pittwater (and the rest of the Northern Beaches too) retain all its C zoned properties as is. We have been campaigning hard on this. This is a huge win for the community, for our landscape and our natural environment.

Central Road Parking restrictions to come

Following community engagement Northern Beaches Council reported that the proposal was amended to retain parking on the northern side and relocate the 'No Parking' restrictions to the southern side of the road. Signage will be installed.
